



Curriculum - Syllabus - Methodology




Curriculum Design Process

- Perform Task



Approaches To Curriculum Development

- ESP (English for Specific Purposes)
- ESP is distinguished from ELT (English Language Teaching), primarily, by increased detail and specific orientation of the needs analysis.

Syllabus Design John Munby

Synthetic vs Analytic Syllabus



Focus on Forms Focus on Form

1. Focus on Forms (associated with synthetic syllabus) = pre-selection of grammar and vocabulary



Focus on Form

2. Focus on Form (associated with analytic syllabus) = teaching of grammar and vocabulary as they arise during the course of a lesson



Negotiated Syllabus

 Instead of teacher choosing content, grammar and vocabulary, <u>the students</u> identify and prioritize what they should learn.



Task Based Language Teaching

 TBLT "Strong Version" = thorough needs analysis, focus on form, task based assessment

 TBLT "Weak Version" = might include focus on forms


Implications for us
