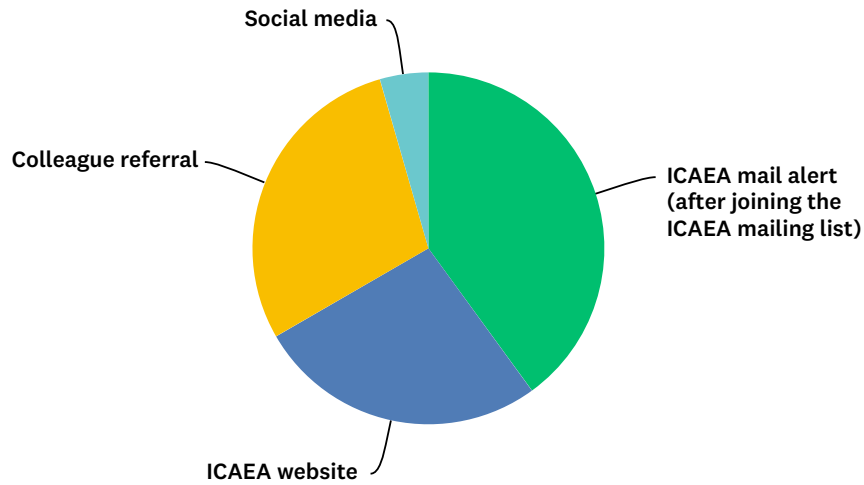


Q1 How did you hear or learn about the conference?

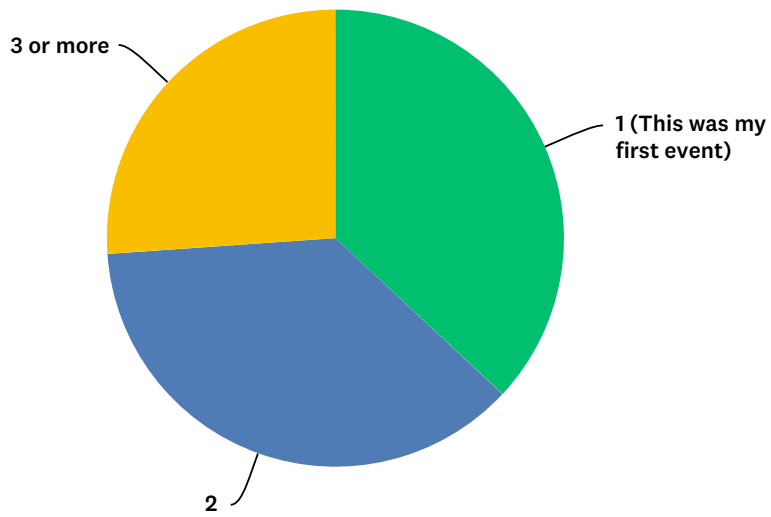

Q2 How many ICAEA events have you attended in the last 5 years?

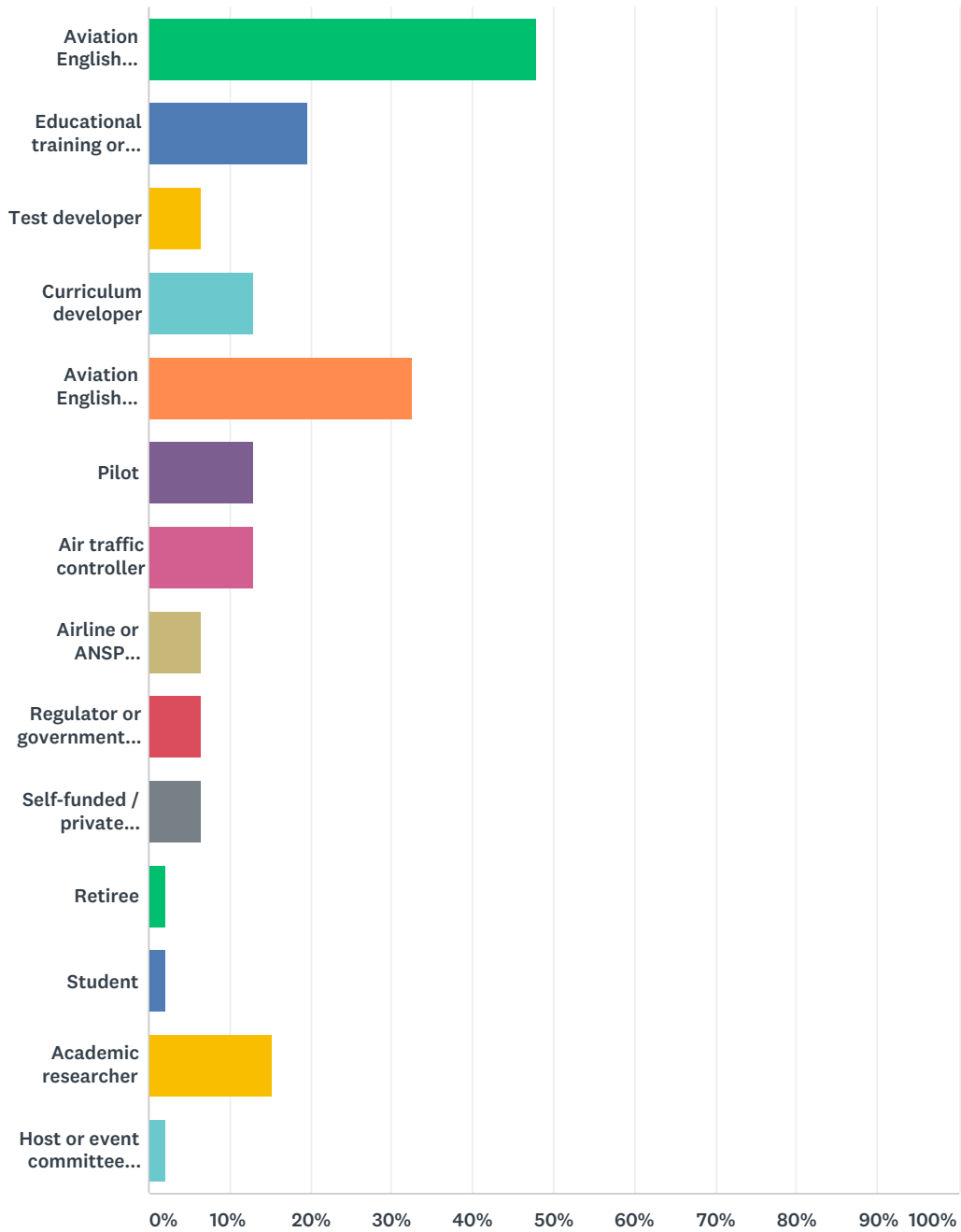

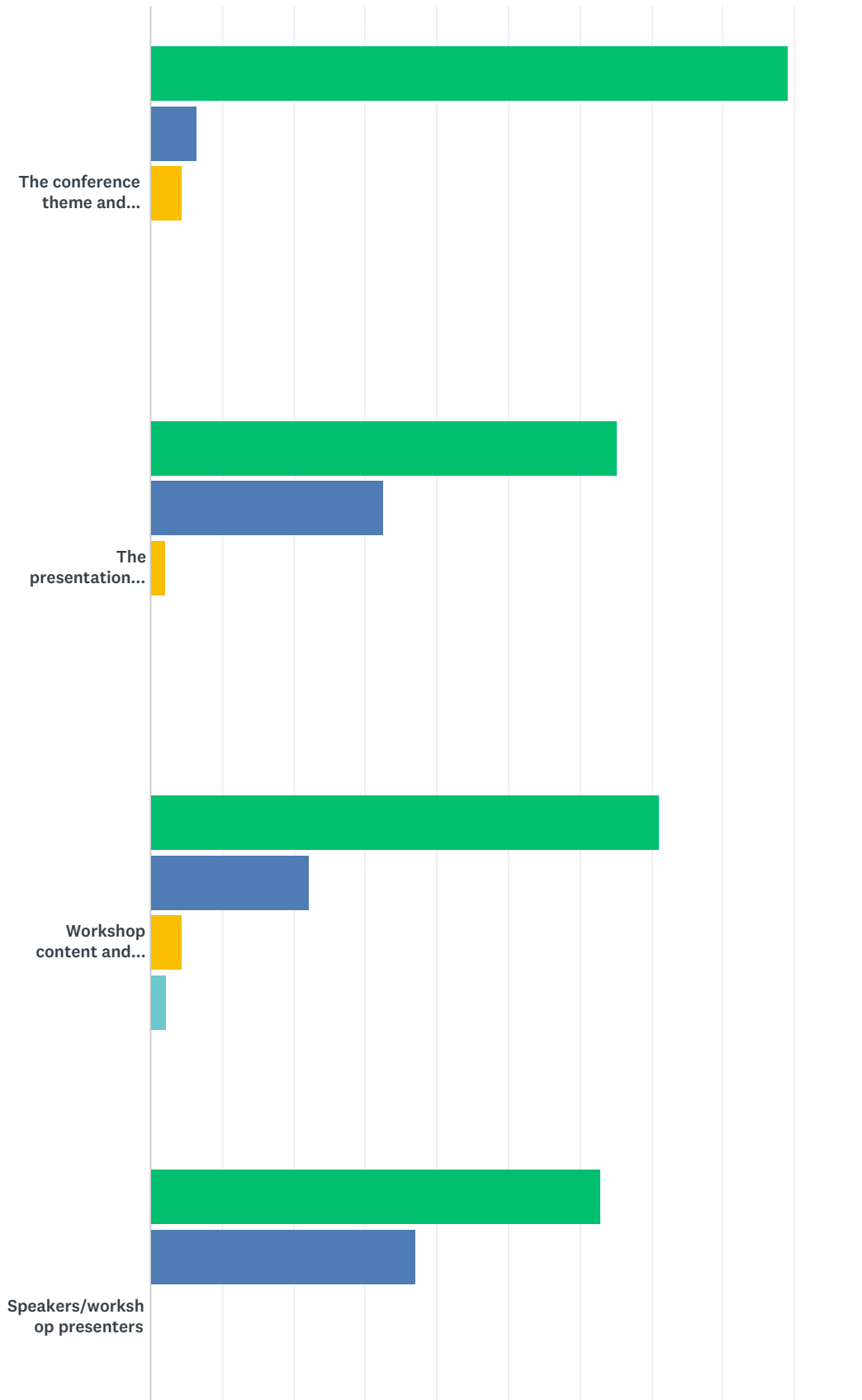

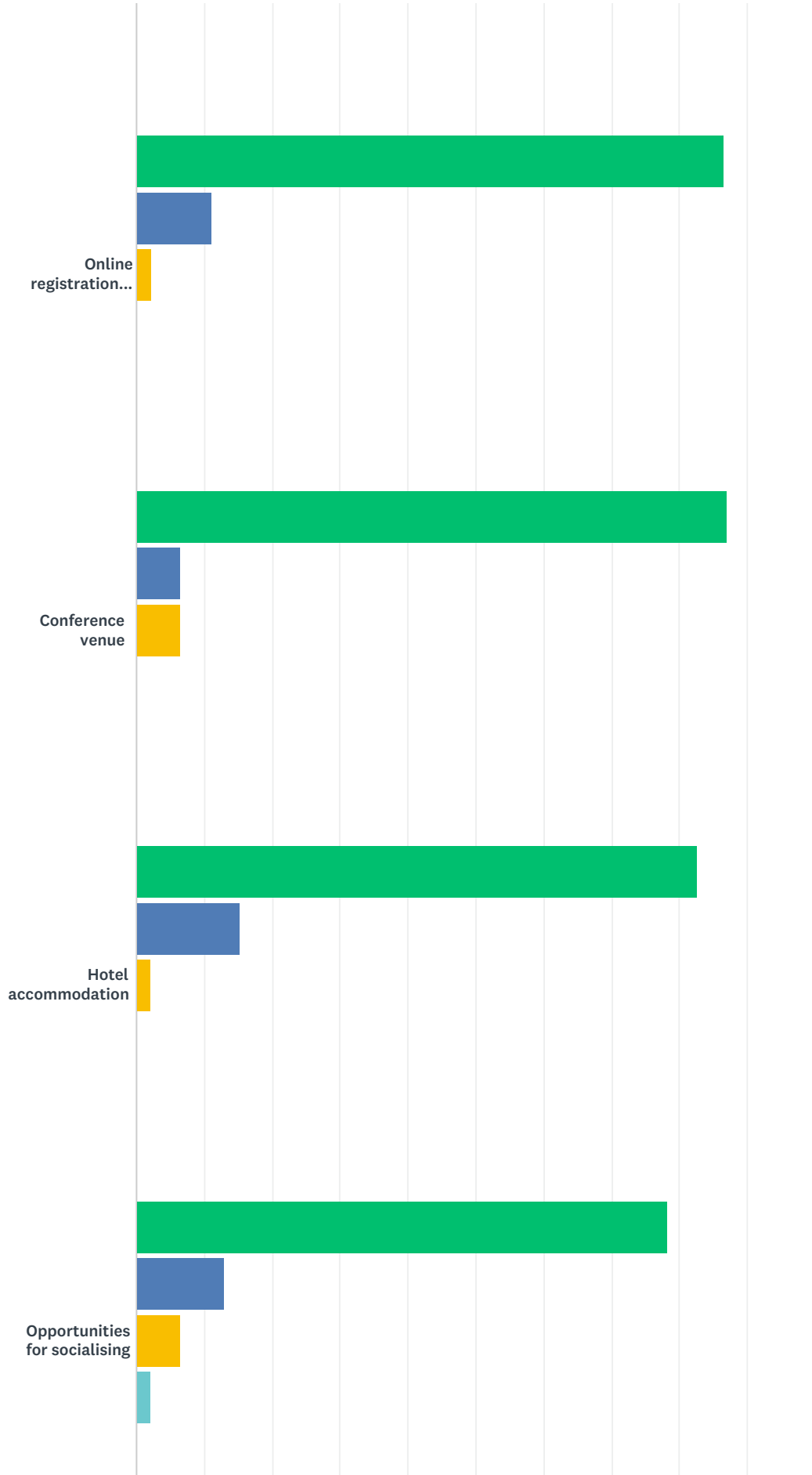

Q4 Please indicate your satisfaction with this event

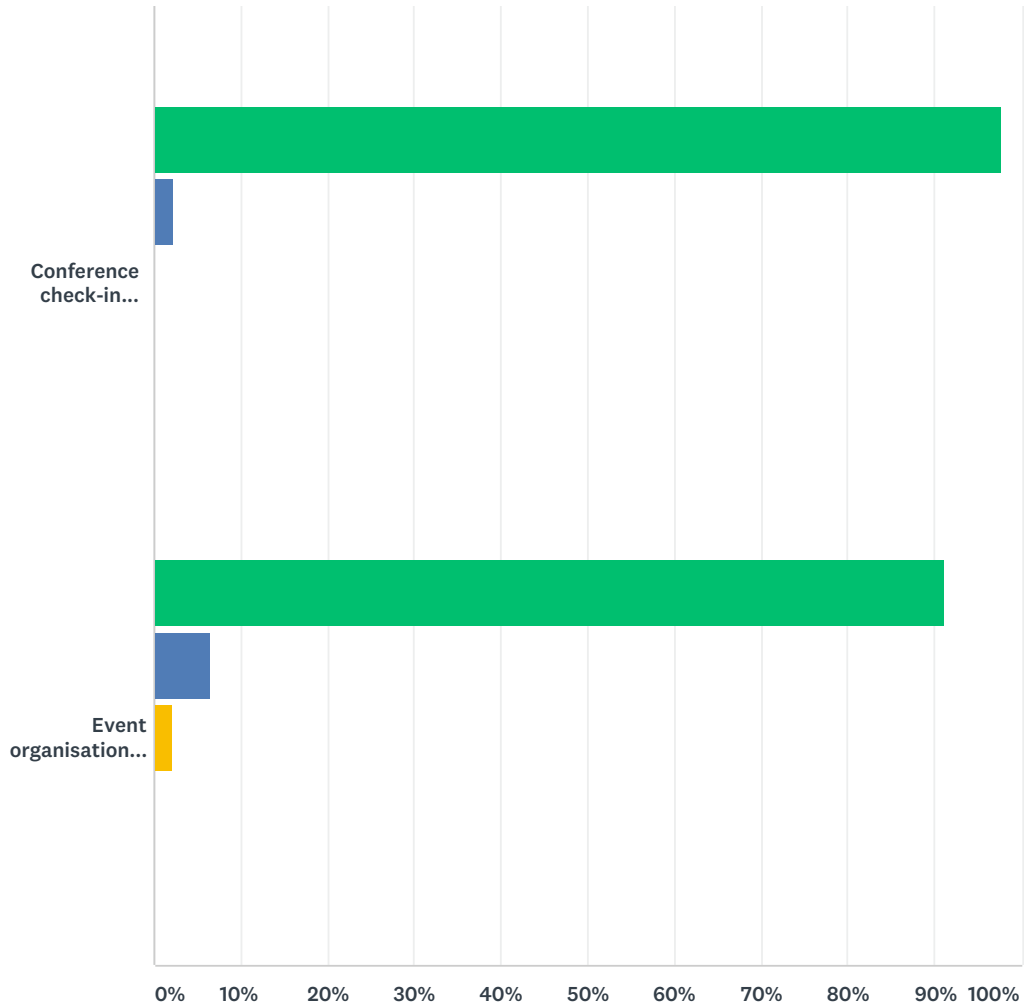

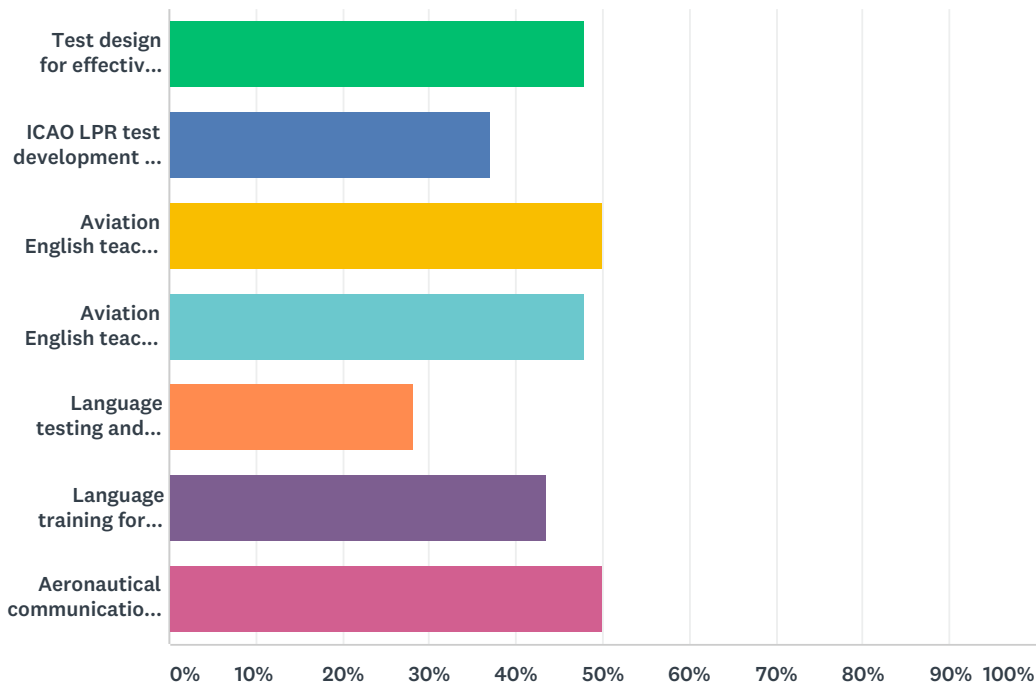

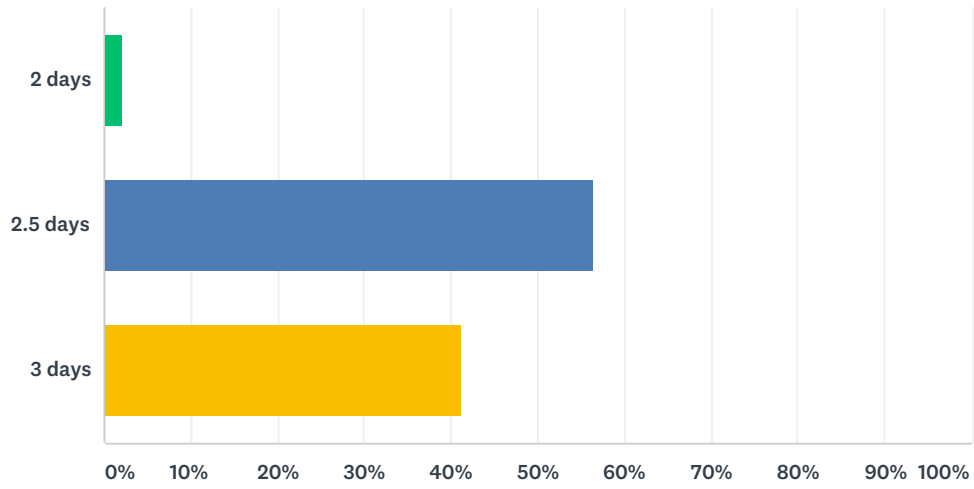

Q6 How many days do you think ICAEA events should be?

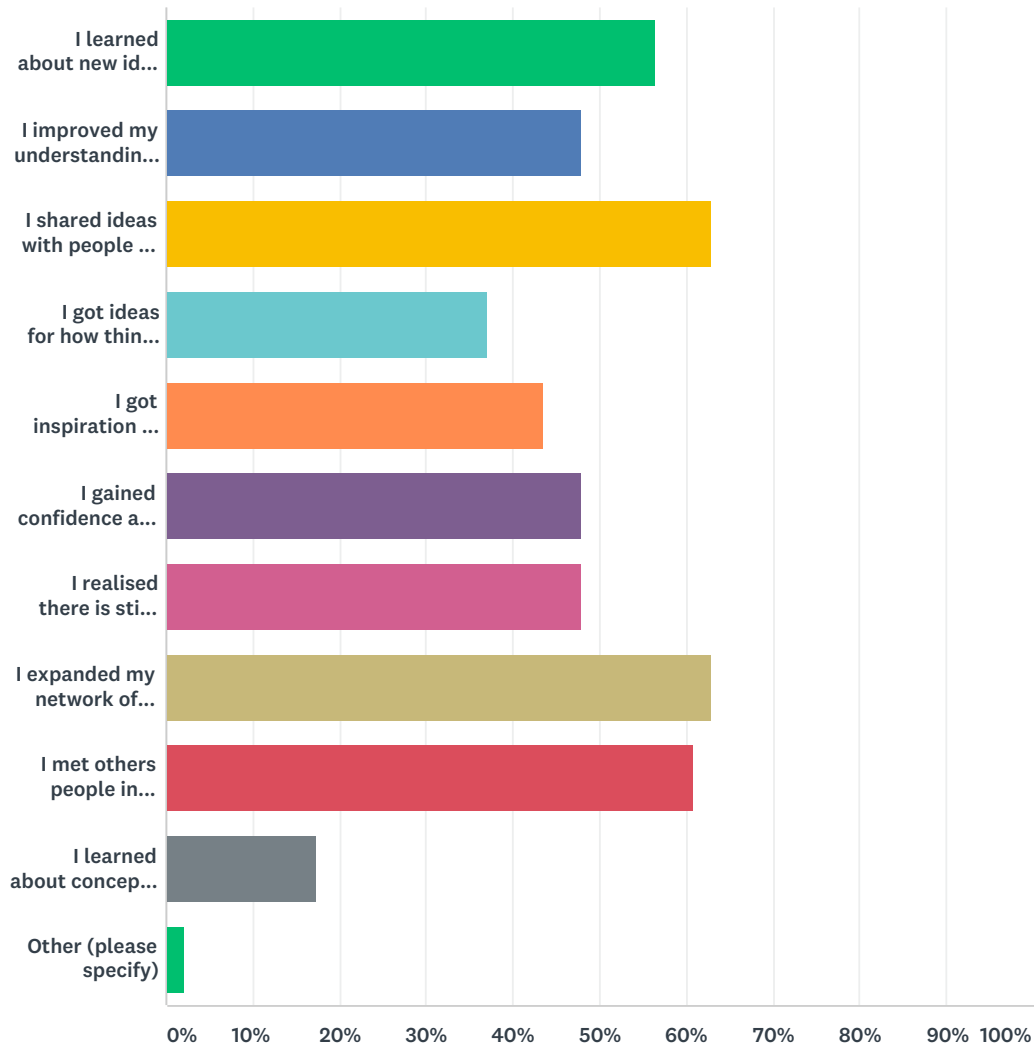

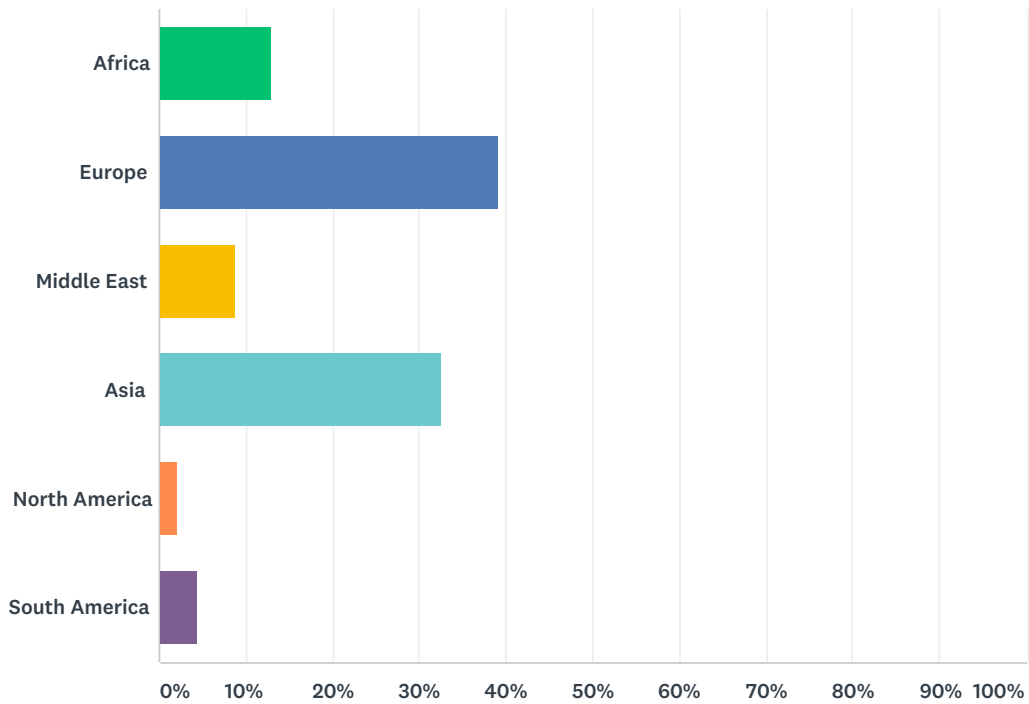

Q8 In which region would you be most interested in attending future ICAEA events?

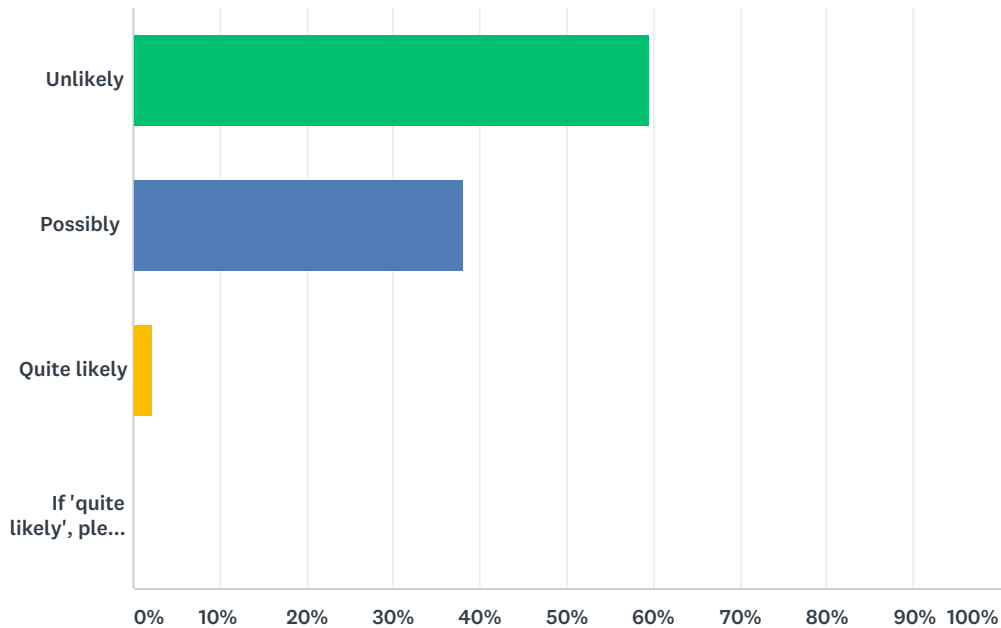
